Research in Tsinghua

Field Trip in Pingyao

The Summer BSF Project was conducted from July 25th to August 2nd in 2018 summer, and in several villages in Pingyao, Shanxi, where many villagers are affected by arsenic in groundwater in China. The Harvard students were instructed by Prof. Lu Xi to build and maintain arsenic removal bio-sand filters in households which only have access to untreated water.
